## James Burton



1930 - 2008

James (Jim) Burton was born on May 22, 1930. He was baptized and received the Holy Spirit in the Church of God. One night he dreamed he was in a large boat rescuing people who appeared to be Latino from drowning. He shared

this dream with his Church of God pastor, who told him he would be a missionary.

The Burton family eventually moved to Ohio, where Jim was introduced to Oneness Pentecostalism. At age seventeen he was baptized in Jesus' name and renewed in the Holy Ghost. He later met Martha Schafer, and the couple married in 1951 while Jim was serving in the US Army. Their union would last fifty-seven years and produce six children.

Brother Burton's dream that he would be a missionary was fulfilled in 1962 when he and Sister Burton were appointed to serve in Venezuela. There were only three Apostolic churches in that nation when the Burtons arrived with their family. In the years that followed, they were instrumental in starting many new churches and establishing Bible schools for ministerial training. Today, there are more than fifteen hundred UPC churches in Venezuela and approximately seventeen hundred ministers. Venezuelan President Carlos Andres Perez even honored Brother Burton for his service to the nation.

Brother Burton served as regional director for South America from 1991 to 1995. One of the Burton's sons, Lonnie (wife Gail), and their grandson, Lonnie James (wife Demarys), succeeded them as missionaries in Venezuela. The Burtons then spent three years as missionaries to Uruguay before retiring in 1999. In total, the couple spent nearly four decades serving in missions.

Brother Burton went home to his eternal reward on September 4, 2008. Sister Burton survives, and currently serves as part of the ministry team at The Calvary Church in Cincinnati, Ohio.

### Martha Burton



1933 - Present

Martha (Schafer) Burton was born on November 23, 1933, in Cincinnati, Ohio, into a family that had been introduced to the Oneness Pentecostal message a few years before. At age eight, Martha was baptized in Jesus' name and filled

with the Holy Ghost. She was only twelve when God spoke to her and said, "Someday you will be on the mission field."

Martha met James (Jim) Burton when she was fifteen. The couple married in 1951 while Jim was in the US Army. Several years later, the Burton family relocated to Minnesota where both Jim and Martha studied at Apostolic Bible Institute. Martha preached her first sermon in a small church in St. Paul Park.

In 1962, the Burtons were appointed as missionaries to Venezuela, fulfilling the promise God made to Martha as a child. She assisted her husband and the Venezuelan church in every way she could, including serving as the national church's treasurer, president of the ladies ministry, and as a Bible school instructor. She also homeschooled the couple's six children, and later a granddaughter. At the same time, the Burtons labored tirelessly to take the gospel to the remotest corners of Venezuela. As a result, the national church grew from three congregations in the early 1960s to more than fifteen hundred churches at present.

Martha and Jim Burton served on the mission field for almost forty years, traveling across South America and to many other parts of the globe. They retired in 1999, and Jim Burton passed in 2008, but Martha continues to serve at The Calvary Church in Cincinnati, Ohio. One of the Burton's sons, Lonnie (wife Gail), along with their grandson, Lonnie James (wife Damarys), carry on the couple's work as missionaries in Venezuela.



# Randy G. Keyes



#### 1950 - present

Randy G. Keyes was born October 7, 1950, in Fresno, California, to Isaac and Bonnie Keyes, devout Oneness Pentecostals who raised Randy and his older brother, Rick, in a home filled with prayer and a strong emphasis on evangelism. Randy received the Holy Ghost at age eleven, and at age fifteen he felt the call to ministry. He eventually enrolled at Western Apostolic Bible College in Stockton, where he met Sharon Langford. The couple soon married

For the next few years, the Keyes alternated between the evangelistic field and serving as pastor of churches in California and Arizona. The couple welcomed their daughter, Kimberly, into the world during this time. In 1981 Brother Keyes became pastor of a church in Modesto, California, turning down offers from three larger congregations because he felt Modesto had the most potential for growth.

The Modesto church grew rapidly under Keyes' leadership. The congregation eventually purchased and remodeled an abandoned theater to accommodate the growing crowds. Today, Revival Church, as it is now known, is a diverse congregation of more than fifteen hundred people that also has planted more than thirty daughter works and preaching points, including many that serve the region's growing Spanish-speaking population. In addition, Revival Church has sponsored and financed evangelism efforts on practically every continent. The church has become known for its annual missions conference, an event which raises substantial funds for evangelism efforts in both North America and abroad.

Brother Keyes also has served the UPCI in many district and national leadership roles. In 2001 he was elected assistant general superintendent, and he currently is an honorary General Board member. He is now the bishop of Revival Church, with his son-in-law, Todd Johnson, succeeding him as pastor.

# L. P. Kilgore



#### 1888 - 1959

Claude Paschal (C. P.) Kilgore was born on July 5, 1888, in Hot Springs, Arkansas. Early life experiences caused him to question the truth of Christianity, so he joined the Mormon church. C. P. married Ella Lee Donaldson on February 2, 1908, and the couple eventually gave birth to ten children. (Their ninth son, James L. Kilgore, would become pastor of Life Tabernacle in Houston, Texas, and an assistant general superintendent of the UPCI. He was inducted into the Order of the Faith in 2002.)

C. P. and Ella Lee Kilgore first heard the Pentecostal message from an Assembly of God evangelist. Ella Lee was the first to receive the Holy Ghost, which prompted C. P. to begin seeking God earnestly. "God filled my soul," he wrote. "For three days and nights the glory of God was on me so great that I could not feel my feet walking on the floor."

After a few years as an Assembly of God minister, Brother Kilgore heard the "blessed truth of baptism in Jesus' name." He was rebaptized in 1921 and felt an overwhelming burden to spread this new message. The Kilgore's early years as traveling evangelists were harsh, but they persevered, preaching in open fields and under tents and brush arbors. God responded by pouring out His Spirit and performing many notable miracles.

More than ten thousand people received the Acts 2:38 experience during the Kilgore's forty-four years of ministry. The couple also pioneered at least fifteen churches. Brother Kilgore was serving as a pastor in Morris, Oklahoma, when he suddenly passed away from a heart attack in 1959. He is remembered as one of early Pentecostalism's most effective evangelists and the author of "The Wheel of Prophecy," one of the most widely distributed pieces of Oneness Pentecostal literature.

# J. Ellis Myers



#### 1935 - Present

J. Ellis Myers was born July 13, 1935, in Pensacola, Florida. At age seventeen he attended a revival service in Niceville, Florida, where he received the Holy Ghost and was baptized in Jesus' name.

Brother Myers soon felt called to ministry and decided to attend Apostolic Bible Institute in St. Paul, Minnesota. He graduated in 1955, and that summer became a credentialed minister with the United Pentecostal Church. The following year, while serving as an assistant pastor in Miami, Florida, he met

Margaret "Debbie" Femino. The couple were married on February 23, 1957.

In the early years of their ministry, the Myers traveled as evangelists and worked in various local churches. The couple established a home missions church in Clearwater, Florida, before becoming pastors of a church in Port St. Joe in 1965. Brother Myers also served as youth president for the Florida District. In 1971, the Myers, along with their two young children, Denise and David, became pastors of a small UPC church in Palm Bay.

Through diligent effort and evangelism, the church in Palm Bay began to grow. Pastor Myers led the congregation through two building programs to accommodate what God was doing. In 1998, he was ordained as bishop of what was by then known as Eastwind Pentecostal Church, with his son, David Myers, assuming the role of pastor. In 2021, the Myers celebrated fifty years of ministry in Palm Bay.

Brother Myers served on the Florida District Board for many years and was named an honorary lifetime member. He and Sister Myers have been married more than six decades. The couple has traveled the globe preaching and teaching God's Word. "Bishop" Myers, as he is affectionately known at Eastwind, continues to be active in ministry.

## Trever B. Neil



#### 1948 - 2016

Trevor Barrington Neil (June 9, 1948 – August 17, 2016) was born in Kingston, Jamaica. Two significant events soon occurred that shaped his future. First, and most importantly, his family found the Apostolic faith. The Neils then moved from Jamaica to England, and finally to Edmonton, Alberta, Canada.

In 1972, Trevor graduated from Northern Alberta Institute of Technology with a degree in engineering. That same year, he experienced the new birth at First United Pentecostal Church in Edmonton. He married Phyllis Gray in

1975, and the couple committed themselves to ministry.

In 1980, the Neils headed north to Fort McMurray, Alberta, where Brother Neil served as a petroleum engineer and pastor of what would become known as Tabernacle of Praise. The tiny congregation faced many challenges, but the Neils worked tirelessly, and the church began to grow.

Brother Neil eventually assumed responsibility for leading two additional churches in Athabasca and St. Albert, Alberta, and he started a daughter work in Grande Prairie. He launched a radio ministry, founded a Christian school, earned a doctorate degree, and started the Genesis Institute of Theology and Evangelism, which is now an endorsed ministry of the UPCI. He also found time to write and publish several books.

In addition to his pastoral responsibilities, Brother Neil was instrumental in developing the Canadian Plains District, which covers the provinces of Alberta and Saskatchewan. He served as district secretary and then superintendent. Brother Neil also was the first Black minister to serve on the UPCI's Executive Board. He helped rebrand Black Evangelism to Building the Bridge, bringing the ministry into alignment with a new generation of leaders. He also created training materials to help UPCI pastors and churches minister across racial, ethnic, and cultural lines. These contributions have been crucial in helping the organization evangelize North America's increasingly diverse population.

Church In a Day (CIAD) was birthed by Church Planter Melvin Milholland, in the early 1980's. He gathered key friends in the construction business to help him build a church in a few weeks in Winslow, AR.

- CIAD has spread to over 44 Districts of the UPCI with many assembling a team to construct a fully furnished church in 24 hours!
- CIAD has completed 153 projects with a total equity of over \$59,000,000 in value to the UPCI.
- CIAD has already completed 3 projects this year with an additional 8 more projects scheduled for 2023.
- To date, 9 church planters have received CIAD guarantees that enabled them to receive **\$1,600,000** in funding and purchases that would not have been approved otherwise.

The program has expanded to offering loan assistance to church planters in their first 10 years through the UPCI Loan Fund. Listed below are some common hurdles church planters face:

- 20% Down Payment CIAD guarantees the down payment up to \$50,000 so a church planter can put down as little as 5%. This removes a major hurdle for church planters.
- Inadequate Cash Reserves If a church planter has a down payment but not enough cash reserves for loan approval, CIAD provides a guarantee to supply the required cash reserves.
- Furniture and Fixtures Many times after building completion, there are no remaining funds for furniture or audio/visual needs. CIAD will guarantee a smaller loan to enable those purchases.

These three summer programs are having an impact on NEXT GEN missionaries and church workers. Next Steps and Apostello are eight weeks of training and apprenticeship on foreign soil for those called to a life of ministry. Our TEFL/TESOL certification program held at World Headquarters is a one-week sixty-hour in-person intensive to give ministry workers an advantage when reaching into new areas with the gospel.
