# ORDER OF THE FAITH



#### UNITED PENTECOSTAL CHURCH INTERNATIONAL

The Order of the Faith, established in 2002, is the United Pentecostal Church International's prestigious award honoring outstanding achievement and exemplary service to the UPCI. Members are chosen by the Pentecostal Heritage Committee and the Executive Board. New members are inducted into the Order of the Faith at the annual general conference. # Edward L. Allard

was born in Bakersfield, California. He came to faith as a teenager and married Amelia in 1956. The Allards began their ministry as lay leaders under Pastor I. H. Terry before entering full-time ministry in 1966 as pastors of a church in Petaluma, California. In 1972, the couple answered the call to missions in West Africa.

Initially assigned to Ghana by the United Pentecostal Church International (UPCI), the Allards helped build churches and teach at the Bible. In 1973, they played a key role in securing governmental approval for the UPCI to minister in Cote d'Ivoire, though they remained based in Ghana until 1975.

In 1976, they were reassigned to Senegal, but a serious car accident in France delayed their move. After months of recovery, the Allards arrived in Senegal in late 1977.

In Senegal, Edward founded a Bible school and secured government recognition for the UPCI. Amelia translated educational materials into French. After five years, they moved to Cote d'Ivoire, where Edward established another Bible school that continues to thrive. His leadership helped expand the UPCI into eight French-speaking African nations, including Mali, Niger, and Gabon.

Edward was later appointed regional supervisor over seventeen West African countries, overseeing a revival that brought more than one-hundred-thousand believers to the faith. After retiring from Global Missions in 2002, the Allards pastored a small church in Dinuba, California, growing it significantly before retiring again.

In their later years, they moved to Delano to attend a church pastored by their son. Edward continued to serve until his health declined. He passed away peacefully on January 7, 2025, leaving behind a legacy of faith, leadership, and a deep love for Africa.



# **David Tatum Elms**

was born in DeLeon, Texas and raised in San Diego, California, where his family became founding members of Revival Tabernacle under Pastor David F. Gray. The church's dynamic ministry deeply influenced David and his three brothers, all of whom became credentialed UPCI ministers.

In 1962, David married Linda Marlene Benson. While working for the Navy and raising a young family, he pursued his dream of teaching, earning a degree in English Literature from San Diego State University in 1971. During this time, his ministry flourished under Pastor Gray's mentorship. Elms served in various roles including youth leader, Bible teacher, and campus ministry director.

In 1973, David and Linda entered full-time evangelism, traveling across the southwestern United States with their three children. Two years later, he accepted the call to pastor First United Pentecostal Church in Charlotte, North Carolina—a role he would hold for nearly fifty years. Under his leadership, the church experienced significant revival. In the mid-1980s, the church received North American recognition as the fastest growing Sunday School in the UPCI.

Elms also played a pivotal role in the development of the UPCI's North Carolina District, serving in nearly every leadership position, including youth president, Global Missions director, and district superintendent. He also became the first national Metro Missions director for North American Missions.

A visionary leader, Elms authored Revival Churches for the Rapture Generation, sharing strategies that shaped church growth across North America. Despite his many responsibilities, he remained deeply devoted to his children and grandchildren and cherishing his sixty-two-year marriage to Linda.

David Elms passed away on January 18, 2025, closing a life marked by faith, leadership, and unwavering devotion.



# Kenneth W. French

was born in Virginia, Missouri, the eldest child of Harry and Anna French. His life was marked by deep conviction and an unwavering commitment to his ideals. His spiritual journey began at age ten, when he was baptized alongside other children from his church.

In 1920, the French family relocated to Roswell, Idaho. There, Kenneth first encountered the Pentecostal message during a 1924 tent revival. He and Louise Fretwell, who later became his wife, embraced the Apostolic faith, eventually parting ways with their Baptist congregation. Kenneth was baptized in Jesus' name but did not receive the Holy Spirit until years

later during a revival in Parma, Idaho, with his wife praying beside him.

After initially resisting a call to missions, Kenneth surrendered to God's will during a solitary prayer meeting. A vision of Alaska confirmed his calling. In 1940, with only thirty-nine dollars, Kenneth and Louise arrived in Sitka, becoming the first Oneness Pentecostal missionaries in Alaska.

The Frenches established the first Pentecostal church in the territory and ministered to students at Mount Edgecumbe boarding school. Moved by the needs of local children, they opened the Pentecostal Children's Home. In 1947, Kenneth launched a boat ministry, taking the gospel to remote coastal villages aboard the Madura.

Following Alaska's statehood, the Frenches continued ministering as home missionaries. Kenneth also edited The Alaska Witness, served as a presbyter, and mentored young ministers. He was deeply respected for his sacrificial service and unwavering love for the people of Alaska.

Kenneth W. French died on November 17, 1980. He is remembered as a pioneer, mentor, and the spiritual father of Alaskan Pentecostals—ever longing to take the gospel "just one more place."



# Eva Juanita Hunt

was a pioneering Pentecostal pastor whose impact extended far beyond her local congregation. Though she initially resisted the call to preach, she embraced it fully after being filled with the Holy Ghost in 1929 and spending years in service and training at Bethel Temple in Decatur, Illinois. In 1941, Sister Hunt held her first service in Pana, Illinois, from the front porch of a home. That humble gathering led to the formation of Full Gospel Church, later renamed First United Pentecostal Church. She pastored the Pana church for twenty-six years, overseeing its growth from small home meetings to the construction and dedication of a permanent church

building in 1947.

Seven additional churches were established throughout central Illinois under Sister Hunt's leadership, and eleven individuals answered the call to ministry through her influence. She also helped revive several struggling congregations. For nineteen years, she served as secretary of Section 5 of the Illinois District UPCI, demonstrating her administrative skill and dedication to the broader Pentecostal movement.

Beyond the church, Sister Hunt was active in civic and interdenominational efforts. She organized the chaplaincy program for the Pana Community Hospital, served with the American Legion Auxiliary, and held leadership roles in the Pana Ministerial Association. In 1963, she was honored as one of three Outstanding Women of the Year by the Illinois State Register.

Eva Hunt's legacy is one of perseverance, humility, and passionate commitment to the gospel. She passed away on April 19, 1995, at the age of ninety-two, leaving behind a lasting spiritual heritage.



# Alonzo Terry

was a pastor, mentor, and advocate for racial harmony and diversity within the Apostolic movement. Born in South Georgia during the Civil Rights era, Terry's early exposure to racial injustice inspired his lifelong commitment to promoting unity and inclusion.

A gifted athlete, Terry earned a football scholarship to Troy University, where a spiritual awakening during a Bible study led him to receive the baptism of the Holy Ghost—an experience that sparked a teamwide revival. Despite facing resistance, including the loss of his football scholarship, Terry founded the first Apostolic campus ministry at Troy.

Over four years, more than 360 students were baptized or filled with the Holy Ghost.

In 1988, Terry and his wife, Kathy, founded Solid Rock Pentecostal Church in Atlanta. Under their leadership, the church became a vibrant, multicultural congregation. Terry also served in various leadership roles within the Georgia District and the United Pentecostal Church International (UPCI), advocating for diversity and mentoring emerging leaders.

He played a pivotal role in transforming Building the Bridge into a national ministry focused on equipping leaders to reach Black communities. He also served on the UPCI General Board, where he championed racial and ethnic inclusion across the UPCI. His ministry and influence helped shift organizational culture toward greater diversity. Terry also founded the Mentorship Conference, empowering pastors and ministry leaders across the country.

His legacy lives on through his family, including his son Nathaniel, who succeeded him as pastor, and through the many lives he touched as a bridge builder and spiritual leader.



# Simeon L. Young, Sr.

born 1939

has held ministerial credentials with the United Pentecostal Church International (UPCI) since 1958. During nearly seven decades of ministry, Young has been a pastor, evangelist, author, and the editor of several publications, including the UPCI's official magazine, Pentecostal Life (Herald).

Born in Boling, Texas, and raised in Texas and Louisiana, Young experienced a colorful childhood that foreshadowed his high-energy preaching style. In 1958, after attending Western Apostolic Bible College, he preached his first sermon and began evangelizing across the US and Canada with his

siblings as the Young Evangelistic Trio. He married Janice Williams in 1963, and together they ministered throughout North America, eventually settling in Houston as assistant pastors.

In 1971, Young became pastor of Kings Highway Tabernacle in Terre Haute, Indiana, where he faithfully served for thirty-five years. During that time, he was editor of the Apostolic World Report and Indiana District Trumpet and authored the widely used Bible study tract Seven Steps to Salvation.

Young's preaching ministry extended globally, reaching countries such as the Philippines, Ethiopia, Pakistan, Sri Lanka, and throughout the Caribbean and Central America. One of his signature sermons, "Journey to a Place Called Revival," was inspired by a visit to a village in Jamaica. Young delivered the sermon more than one hundred times, often upon request.

A major highlight of Young's legacy was his nine-year tenure as editor of the Pentecostal Herald. His editorials were later compiled in A Piece of My Mind, which was published in 2014.

In 2013, Young joined Emmanuel Pentecostal Church in Mesquite, Texas, as a pastoral elder. He and Janice continue to serve in that capacity

He was the founding president and currently is the chancellor of Urshan College and Urshan Graduate School of Theology. He earned the Master and Doctor of Theology in New Testament from the University of South Africa, Doctor of Jurisprudence with honors from the University of Texas, and Bachelor of Arts magna cum laude in mathematical sciences and managerial studies from Rice University. The author of thirty books with a circulation of over one million, he has been published in forty-two languages and has ministered in eighty countries on six continents. He and his wife, Connie, have three children and eight grandchildren.



#### **Josh Carson**

Joshua B. Carson is the senior pastor of Calvary Tabernacle in Indianapolis, Indiana. In turn, he also serves as the president

MARHABA Center is a strategic outreach initiative of the Detroit Metro District (DMD) dedicated to serving Middle Eastern Immigrants, predominantly Muslims from Access Challenged Nations (ACN) located in Dearborn, Michigan. The name *MARHABA*, meaning "welcome" in Arabic, also has a significant meaning in Aramaic: "The Lord is Love."

# Why Does MARHABA Center Exist?

Our mission is to establish a welcoming space where Apostolics can connect with and build meaningful relationships among some of North America's most unreached people groups. Through this engagement, we aim to foster evangelism and discipleship, reflecting Christ's love in action.

No one is better positioned to reach Muslims than Oneness Apostolics who pursue a life of holiness that Muslims respect and experience the miraculous that they seek.

Dearborn, Michigan, has the highest concentration of Middle Easterners and the largest mosque in North America. The US and Canada have 161 unreached people groups, 111 (69%) of which are Muslims.






### **Chad Wicker**
